There will be marshals in each of these locations. All the above car parks are within a 10-minute jog to the race start- please allow extra time for this.

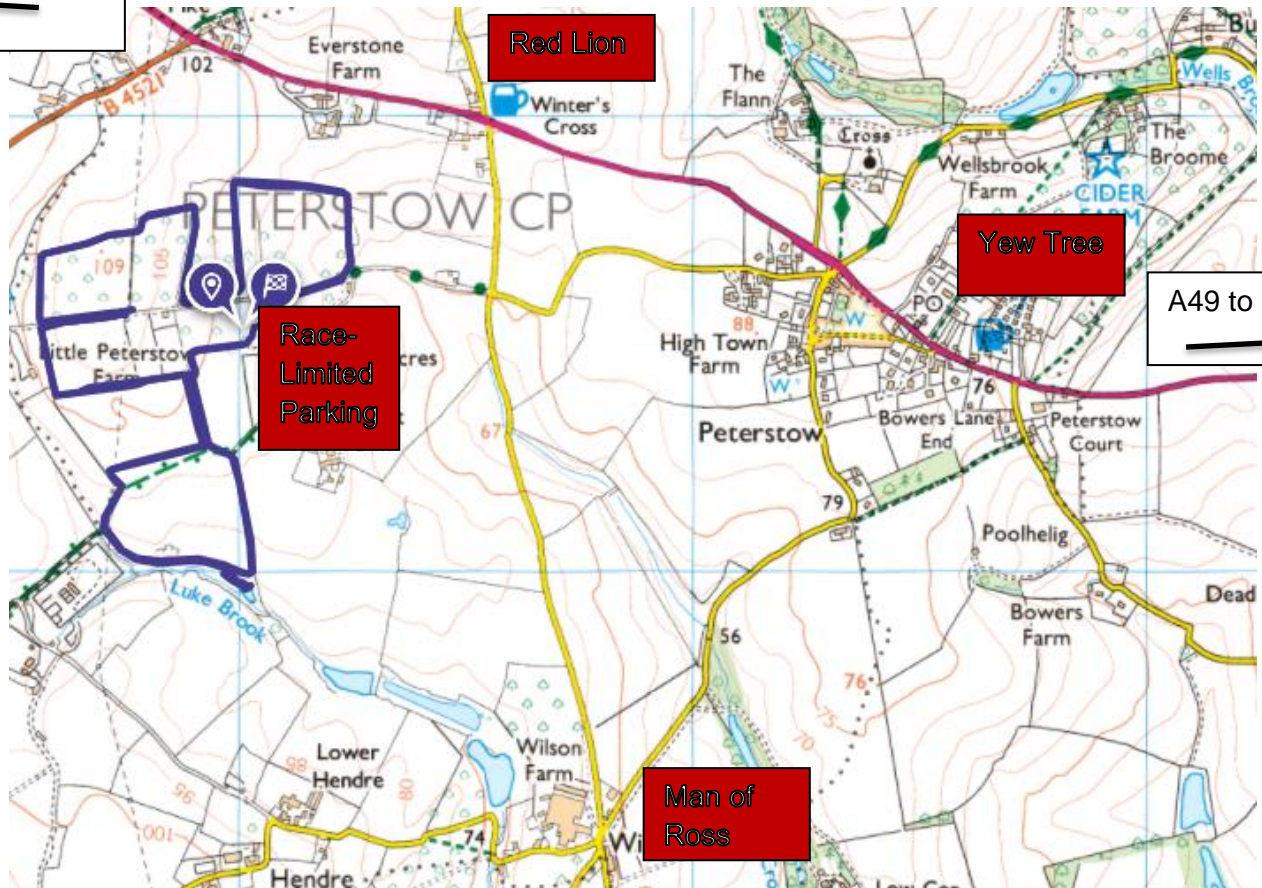
There is a dry barn for storage and shelter: Please bring warm clothes!

Facilities

The course is based on the grounds of a working fruit farm in South Herefordshire; mildly undulating with the potential for it to be very muddy and/or rutted, dependent on the weather. There are two short sections of concrete path.

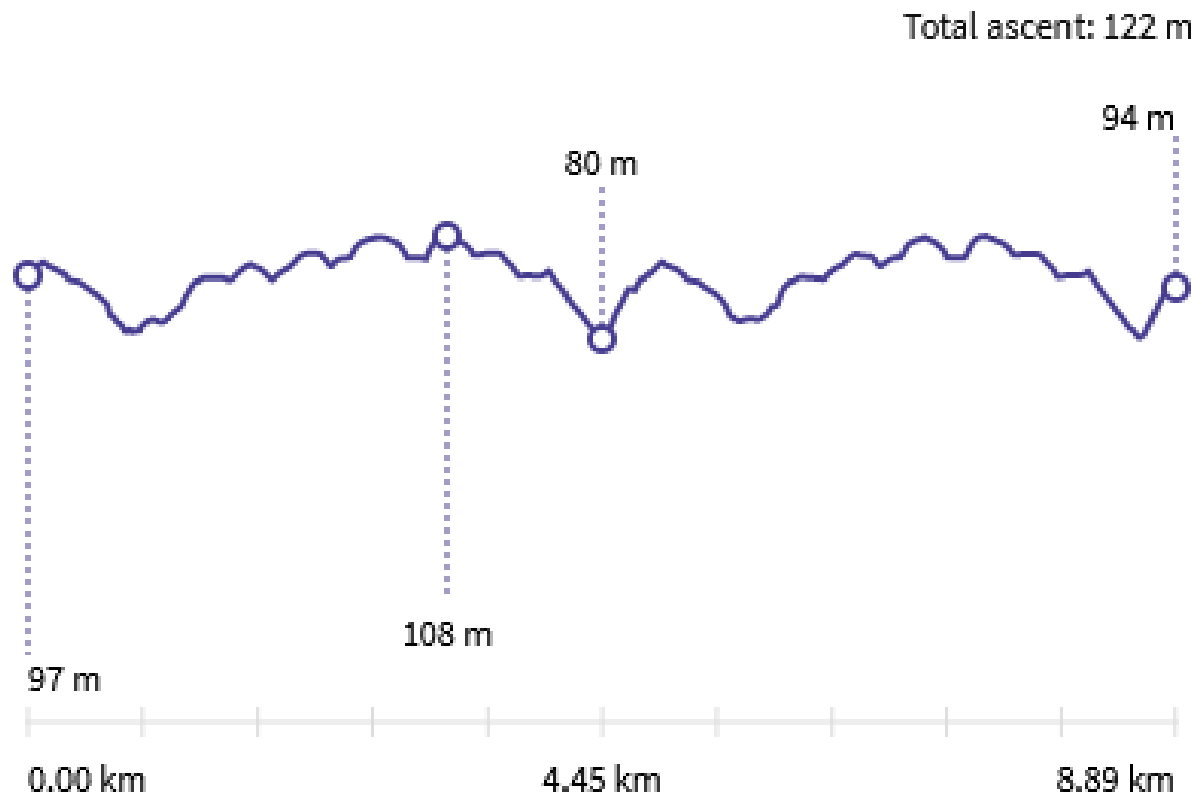
For Juniors over 17 it's a 1 lap, 2.8-mile course. For everyone else it's a 2 lap, 5.8-mile course.
